Gifts of Spirit (1 Corinthians 12:8-11)

Prophecy, Miracles, Evangelism, Tongues, Interpretation of Tongues, Healing, Faith, Discerning spirit, Wisdom.

7 OT gifts Isaiah (Isiah 11:1-2)

Wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord.

Fruits of the spirit (Galatians 5:22-23)

But the fruit of the Spirit is *love*, *joy*, *peace*, *forbearance*, *kindness*, *goodness*, *faithfulness*, *gentleness* and *self-control*. Against such things there is no law.

The promised spirit -the mark of a seal, deposit. (Ephesians 1: 13-14) (Ownership for us to possess if we seek it, claim it and live it.) Deposit from Greek ἀρραβών (ar-hrab-ohn') of Hebrew origin.
